Sun. 21 Oct 2018 After your flight, take a transfer to Reykjavik, via the Blue Lagoon. Enjoy a peaceful time at the Blue Lagoon, a unique natural pool of mineral rich geothermal water located in the middle of a lava field in the pure, beautiful Icelandic wilderness. The Blue Lagoon is known for its special properties and its beneficial effects on the skin, and attracts visitors from all over the world in search of health, relaxation and an exotic experience. In addition to bathing in the lagoon, guests have access to a sauna with a view of the lagoon, a steam-bath with white walls that resemble silica-mud and a cozy steam-bath carved into a lava cave. This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner with the group at a local restaurant. Tonight, you join a mysterious tour, looking for the Aurora Borealis, on a dark winter night in Iceland. Far from the glow of the city, we hunt for the elusive Northern Lights. (D)

Mon. 22 Oct 2018 Breakfast at the hotel. Reykjavik is affectionately called the Biggest Little City in the World. On today's sightseeing tour, you will explore Reykjavik's top attractions, and hear interesting facts and stories that relate to history and culture in Iceland.

On this tour, you will enjoy spectacular views from the platforms at Perlan, which is built on the city's hot water tanks. You will then proceed to visit Hallgrimskirkja church, whose design was inspired by basalt lava columns, a common volcanic rock formation in Icelandic nature. Last but not least, you will tour the old town center with the Icelandic parliament Althingi and the town hall. Drop off at your choice after the tour. You will have the rest of the day and evening at leisure after this 2-3 hour tour. (B)

Tues. 23 Oct 2018

Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up at your hotel after breakfast. Today you will drive along the south coast, one of the country's most scenic regions. Along the way we stop at the gorgeous Seljalandsfoss waterfall, where you can walk behind it and through to the other side. We also stop at the majestic and much-photographed Skogafoss waterfall, with its 60-metre drop. Other highlights include views of the stunning Myrdalsjokull glacier, the black sand coastline, the charming village of Vík, and the impressive Reynisdrangar rock formations. We will make a stop at the LAVA Center in Hvolsvöllur, an interactive, high-tech educational exhibition depicting volcanic activity, earthquakes and the creation of Iceland over millions of years. Return to your hotel in Reykjavík for evening at leisure. Duration of tour: 10 hours (B)

Wed. 24 Oct 2018

Breakfast at the hotel. The Golden Circle is probably the most popular day tour for several good reasons. This is a full-day tour of the south-west of Iceland and includes three of the best known attractions Iceland has to offer. The first is Gullfoss (The Golden Waterfall), one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe with thousands of tons of icy water thundering majestically into a deep canyon. The second is the Geysir Area, with numerous hot springs, fumaroles and geysers, including the 30 meter spouting world known Strokkur. Last is Þingvellir, a remarkable geological site and a historic site as well. Þingvellir is the site of the world's oldest democratic parliament founded in 930 and the beautiful canyon running through the park is actually the dividing fault line between two of the earth's tectonic plates. (B)

Thurs. 25 Oct 2018

Breakfast at the hotel. Pick up at your hotel after breakfast for today's touring. After nearly five years of studying, planning, modelling and careful preparation by top engineers, as well as advice from world renowned geo physicists with expert level knowledge of glaciers, you are now able to explore the Langjokull ice tunnel, located high on Europe's second largest glacier. The Langjokull ice tunnel is the world's first, and biggest, man-made Ice Cap Glacier tunnel.

This adventurous, once in a lifetime journey to the heart of an Ice Cap Glacier, starts with a bus ride to the area of Borgarfjordur. On the way to the edge of the glacier you'll stop and witness natural phenomena such as

Deildartunguhver, the largest hot spring area in Europe, and Hraunfossar Waterfalls, a series of waterfalls formed by rivulets streaming over a distance of about 900 meters out of a lava field.

When you reach Langjokull glacier, it's time to board a monster 8 wheel glacier truck to reach the entrance of the ice cave. During the excursion within the glacier itself you'll see colors of blue you never knew existed, and learn how glaciers hide the secrets of history.

After an approximately 50 minute visit within the glacier, it's time to head back to your hotel in Reykjavik. (B)

Fri. 26 Oct 2018

Breakfast at hotel. On today's tour, you will walk down into the Leiðarendi lava cave and discover the marvels that the volcanoes have created. The cave is a great example of an Icelandic lava tube, full of volcanic rock formations in a dark world beneath ours.

You'll witness 2000 years of natural history as you explore the stalagmites of the Leiðarendi cave. Only 25 km (16 miles) from Reykjavik, and a short walk from the road, the 750 metre (2,297 foot) cave is easily accessible, and suitable for everyone. Return to your hotel in Reykjavik for afternoon and have a farewell dinner at a local restaurant. (B/D)
